1. Go to my website <http://indrihovic.com> or <http://www.indrihovic.com>
2. Navigate through the website to find items such as my office hours, course syllabus/outlines, and etcetera. Read and print a copy of the following files:
(1) **important student information** (2) **course syllabus** (3) **course outline**
3. If you are unfamiliar with MyMathLab (MML) or the Math Hub, read the MyMathLab/Hub files from the website (MyMathLab is aka MML or Course Compass)
4. Register and/or signup for this math course using an Access Code. An Access Code is inside the cardboard folder that the publisher bundled with your textbook. Access Codes may also be purchased online with a credit card at <http://coursecompass.com> or through the bookstore. **TROUBLE GETTING ACCESS CODE QUICKLY? -- IF SO, SEE ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!!!** When signing up for the course, you will also need the Course ID. See the bottom of the page to obtain the Course ID. If you do **not** logon by 10:00 AM, Friday, January 13, I will withdraw you from the course.
5. Navigate MML. Look at the calendar for due dates of assignments. You can use MML to do homework problems, take tests, view your calculated grade so far, read announcements from me, and much more. If you miss a homework problem, click “similar exercise.” This will give you three additional opportunities to get it correct. **EVERYONE SHOULD BE ABLE TO GET NEARLY 100% ON HOMEWORK** – MML lets you keep working on a problem until you get it right. You want to complete all your homework before taking a test; you will see a correlation between the homework and the unit tests.
6. Find the Testing/Tutoring rooms of the Hub and the times these rooms are open. If you have questions about MML, someone in tutoring will assist you. It is a good idea to bring your College ID with you when using the Hub. The website for the Hub is <http://math.fdtc.edu>.
7. Obtain calculator programs from your instructor.
